EVRT launches a new Campaign to develop an accessible Woodland Trail & Natural Play Area.

We are launching a project to design a wheelchair-accessible sensory woodland trail that caters to families, children, and nature enthusiasts of all ages.

This trail will provide a natural immersive experience that connects visitors with the natural environment while offering both formal and informal learning opportunities. The trail will be situated within our existing woodland habitat, and will make the best use of existing features and natural elements.

We hope this trail will provide opportunities for wellbeing courses, outdoor skills & learning workshops as well as an accessible recreation space for all people.
